Background

- This report presents three calculations - cohort graduation rate, cohort dropout rate and single-year dropout rate.
- The cohort graduation and dropout rates track the classes (cohorts) of 2007, 2008, and 2009. Cohorts are tracked beginning with the tenth grade.
- The Utah State Office of Education (USOE) uses a Statewide Student Identifier (SSID) to accurately track each student.
- The class of 2007 is the first high school cohort to participate in this longitudinal data system.
- The single-year dropout rate calculates the percentage of secondary students who dropped out of school in a single year, regardless of their cohort.
- Data collection and calculation methods have remained constant for these three years, making these data comparable.

State Cohort Graduation Rate Highlights

- Utah's statewide cohort graduation rate has remained constant at 88% for 2007, 2008 and 2009.
- Among ethnic groups, Hispanic students had the lowest graduation rate (70%) and Caucasian students had the highest graduation rate (91%).
- For the class of 2009, 95% of high school graduates passed the Utah Basic Skills Competency Test (UBSCT).
- The cohort dropout rate mirrors the cohort graduation rate (12% dropout, 88% graduation rate).

Single-Year Dropout Rate Highlights

- Single-year dropout rates have improved each school year from 2006-07 (4.5%) to 2008-09 (3.3%).
- For the 2008-09 school year, American Indian students had the highest single-year dropout rate (7.1%) and Asian students had the lowest single-year dropout rate (2.0%).
- 51% of all single-year dropouts in the 2008-09 school year were twelfth grade students. The single-year dropout rate by grade approximately doubles for each grade from seventh through twelfth grade.



Section 1: State Cohort Graduation Rates

Definitions

The Utah state cohort graduation rate is the percentage of students in a high school graduation cohort who received a diploma from a Utah public school prior to September 30 of their graduation year. The Utah State Office of Education (USOE) tracked the students in each graduating class individually from their tenth grade year and determined the final high school completion status of each student at the end of the summer after their twelfth grade (senior) year. This has been made possible by statewide implementation of a unique student identifier (SSID) and the design and implementation of an education data warehouse by the USOE to integrate and store multiple years of data submitted by schools and districts. The class of 2007 is the first cohort to be tracked in this way.

The USOE applied a formula for the cohort graduation rate required by the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) and specifically approved for use in Utah by the United States Education Department (USED). The formula is simply the number of graduates in the cohort divided by the number of graduates plus dropouts in the cohort, with students who transferred out of the public education system excluded from the computation.

Cohort graduation rates and dropout rates always total 100%. For example, if the graduation rate is 88%, the dropout rate is 12%. 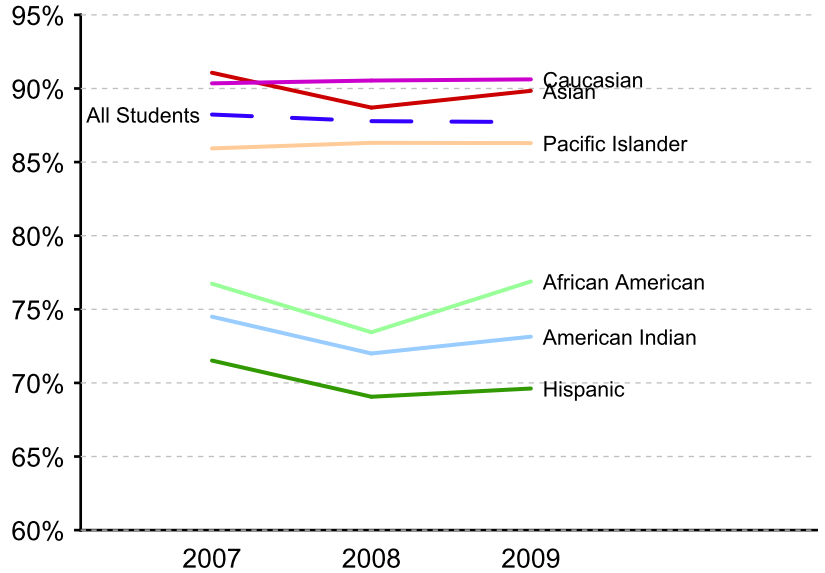

Section 1: Charts - State Cohort Graduation Rates by Subgroups

The state average graduation rate has remained stable at 88% for three years. While Hispanic, American Indian and African American students have the lowest graduation rates, their rates have improved between 2008 and 2009.

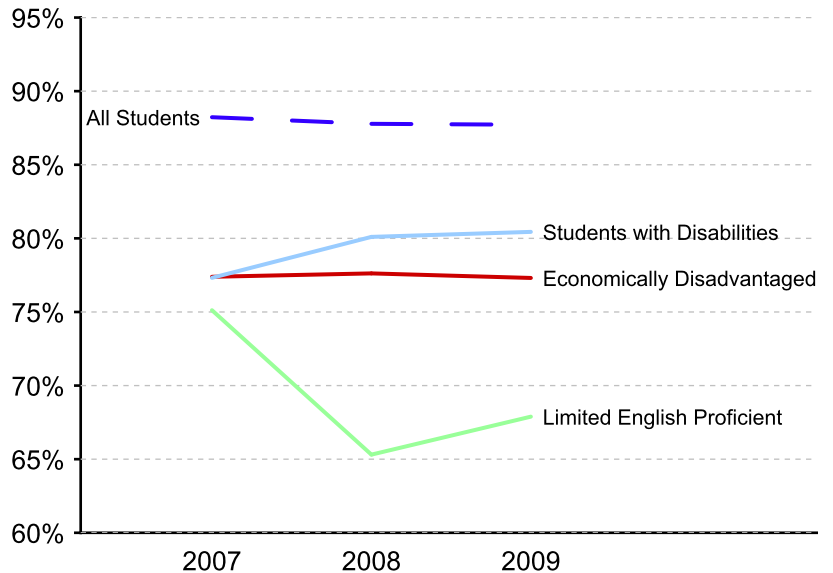
State Cohort Graduation Rate - Ethnicity



Limited English Proficient (LEP) students, Economically Disadvantaged students, and Students with Disabilities historically underperform as compared to the state average. Graduation rates for these groups have not significantly improved in recent years.

The criteria for determining which students qualified for the LEP group changed in 2008; and therefore, LEP data for 2008 and 2009 are not comparable to data for 2007.

Section 2: Single-Year Dropout Rates

Definitions

This section presents the percentage of secondary students who dropped out of school in a single year. The business rules for determining who is a dropout follow the requirements of the U.S. Department of Education as detailed in their Education Data Exchange Network (EDEN) and National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) Common Core of Data (CCD) specifications.

A dropout is an individual who (1) was enrolled in school at some time during a school year, and (2) was not enrolled on October 1 of the following school year, and (3) has not graduated from high school or completed a State or district approved educational program, and (4) does not meet any of the following exclusionary conditions: (a) transfer to another public school district, private school or State or district approved educational program (including correctional or health facility programs), (b) temporary absence due to suspension or school-excused illness, or (c) death.

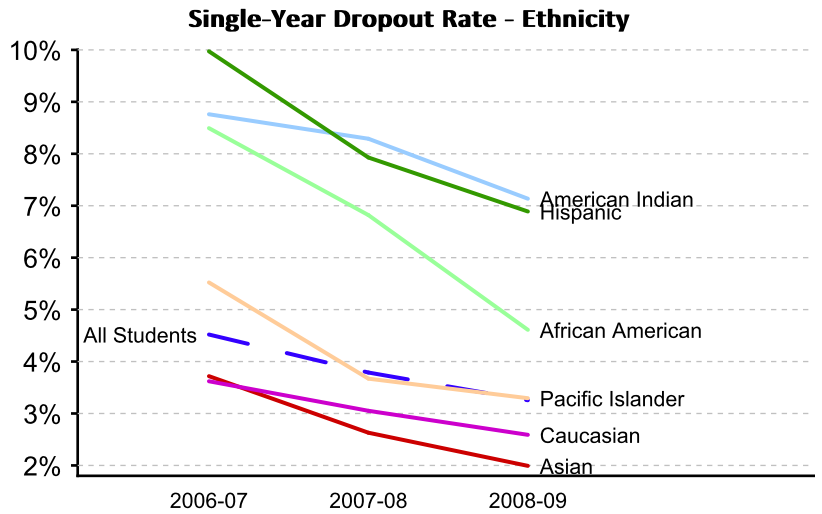
Students who drop out multiple times in a school year are reported only once for a single school year at the state level. However, students who drop out in more than one year are reported as dropouts for every year in which they drop out.

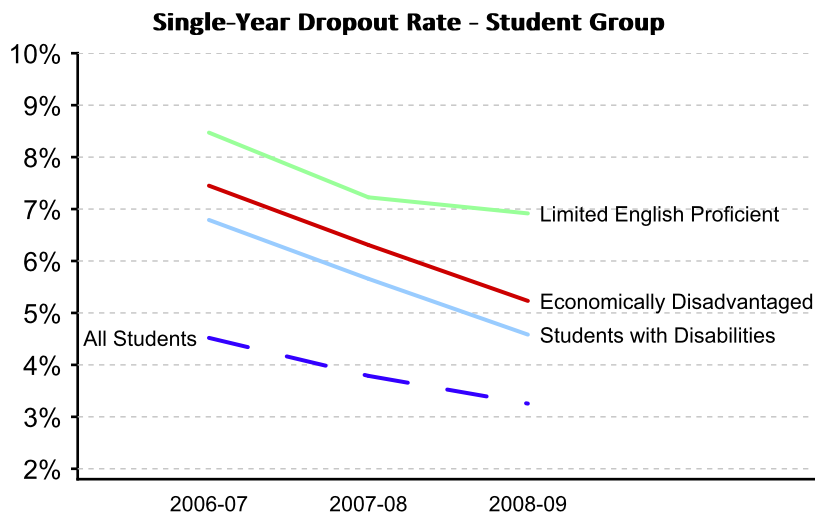


Section 2: Charts - Single-Year Dropout Rates by Subgroups

Single-year dropout rates for all ethnic groups have shown improvement by declining for two consecutive years. Rates for American Indian and Hispanic are significantly higher than the state average.

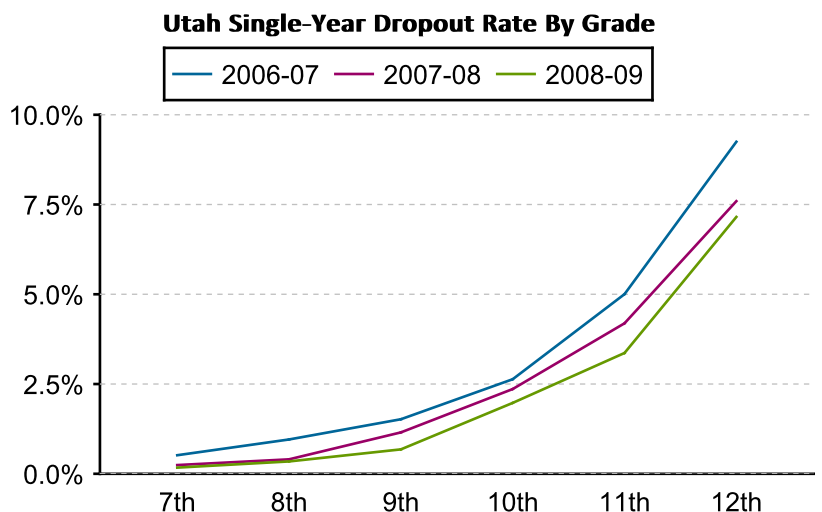


Single-year dropout rates for Limited English Proficient (LEP) students, Economically Disadvantaged students and Students with Disabilities have also shown improvement by declining for two consecutive years. LEP students have the highest single-year dropout rates for this three year period.



The criteria for determining which students qualified for the LEP group changed in 2009-08; and therefore, LEP data for 2007-08 and 2008-09 are not comparable to data for 2006-07.

The single-year dropout rate by grade approximately doubles for each grade from seventh through the twelfth grade. 51% of all dropouts in the 2008-09 school year were twelfth grade students.
