### HOW TO TRANSLATE A FOREIGN NEWSPAPER OR MAGAZINE

1. Go to our Library Website: [www.uteed.net/utelibrary.htm](http://www.uteed.net/utelibrary.htm)
2. Go to our “Newspapers & Magazines” Collection and find “U.S. and World Newspapers”

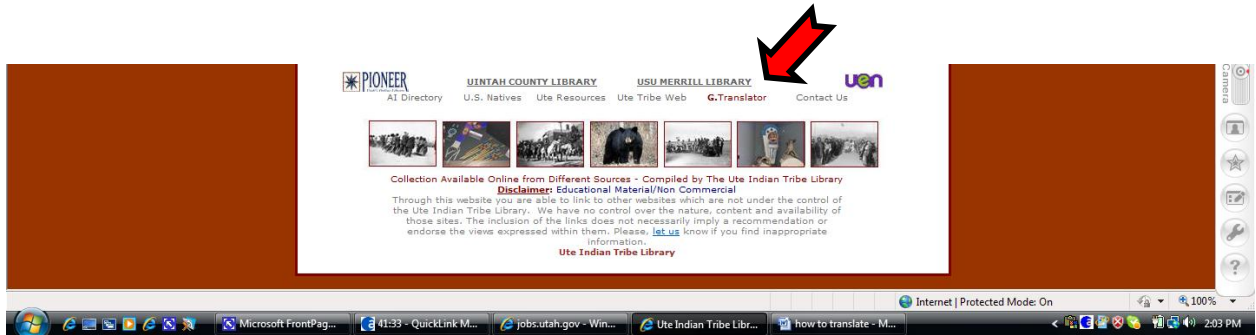
3. Find the Newspaper you would like to translate to English and copy (Control+C) its web site address (sample: <http://www.lanacion.com.ar/>)

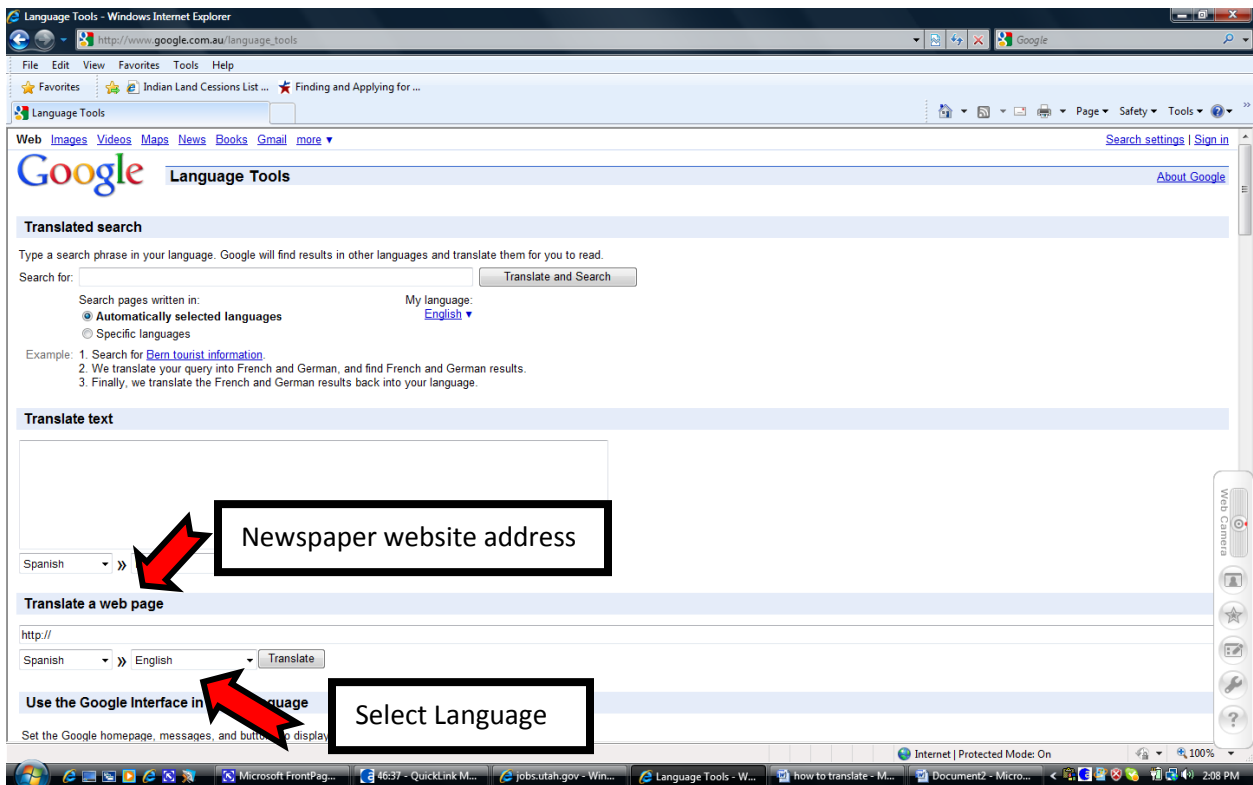
